while traveling the mountain path.

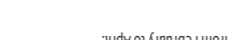
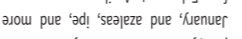
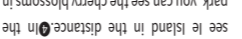
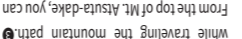
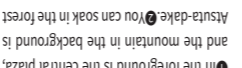
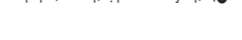
● From the top of Mt. Atsuta-dake, you can

In Kenmin-no-mori, there is a large campsite where you can set up more than 100 tents. There are facilities such as kitchens, toilets and showers, and also tents and tables available for rent, so you can relax and enjoy camping. Surrounded by the forest the site is pleasant and you can see the sky full of stars at night.

When you're walking through the woods, you can find acorns!

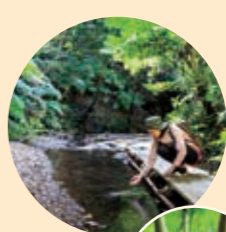


You can see the Japanese Snowbell from December to March.

In the park there are three courses to climb Mt. Atsuta-dake. All of them are well maintained, making it easy for beginners and children to walk around. You can enjoy hiking to the top while soaking up the nature. The top is 165 m tall, and has a great view where you can see Motobu Peninsula and Ie Island. While the Needlewood Tree blooms in May, the Japanese Stone Oak produces acorns in autumn, so keep an eye out for them.

The water in the stream is cool and refreshing.



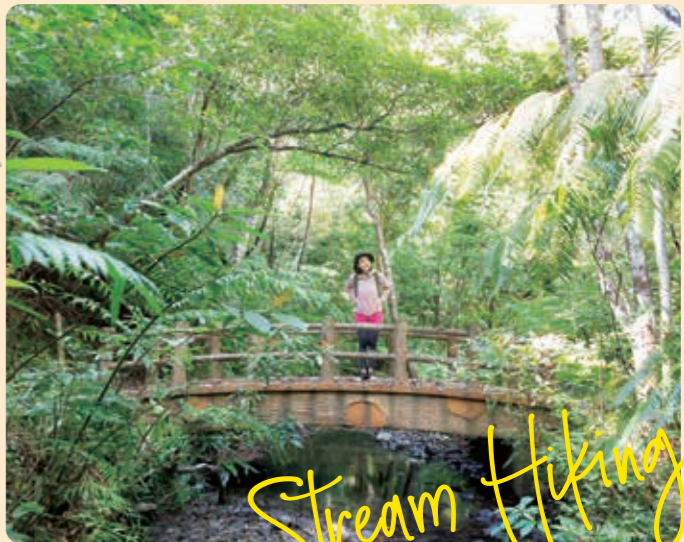
A Flying Spider-monkey Tree Fern with a round new bud that looks like a cat's paw.

There is also a promenade along the stream, it is cool even in summer and you can have fun playing around in the water. There are different plants here than on the top of the mountain: many species of fern plants such as the Turnip Fern and the Flying Spider-monkey Tree Fern, and also the Miyagi Oak which grows the largest acorns in the country. There are many creatures living in the forest and if you listen carefully you can hear the chirps of various birds and insects.
